Powerco is New Zealand's second largest electricity and gas distribution utility with around 430,000 consumers connected to its networks. Powerco's electricity networks are in Western Bay of Plenty, Thames, Coromandel, Eastern and Southern Waikato, Taranaki, Whanganui, Manawatu and the Wairarapa. Its gas pipeline networks are in Taranaki, Hutt Valley, Porirua, Wellington, Horowhenua, Manawatu and Hawke's Bay.

Effective from 1 April 2016, this disclosure details our new line charges in accordance with the Electricity Distribution Information Disclosure Determination 2012.
